



EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

UNCONSCIOUS PLAYER

- Check for breathing.
 - If breathing call ambulance.
 - If not breathing commence CPR, call ambulance.
- Get someone to call parents to meet at hospital.
- First aider to travel to hospital with child if parents are not there.
- Fill in accident book

MAJOR INJURY

- If player cannot move or you think that moving player might cause harm
 - Call ambulance.
 - First aider travel to hospital with child if parents are not there.
 - Call parents ask them to come to venue or meet at hospital.
 - Fill in accident book
- If player can move, remove from field of play,
 - Arrange transport to hospital or call ambulance if you feel out of your depth.
 - Call parents if they are not present
 - First aider travels to hospital with child to meet parents there.
 - Fill in accident book

HEAD INJURY - Perform concussion assessment

- If you are satisfied player is not concussed
 - Allow them to continue playing
 - Inform parents that player banged head but was not concussed
 - Fill in accident book
- Concussion
 - Remove child from field immediately
 - Call parents and ask them to collect child asap
 - Tell them to take child for concussion assessment or call their GP for advice. Remind them of seriousness of concussion.
 - Fill in accident book

MINOR BUMPS AND BRUISES, SPRAINS ETC

- First aider can give minor first aid but cannot administer any drugs.
- If player has difficulty walking call parents and ask them to collect child.
- Fill in accident book
