Parent's Disciplinary Procedure

1. First Minor breach :

1. A meeting will be arranged with the parent(s) to discuss the breach of the club's behaviour expectations. This will include a clear explanation of the issue and how it goes against the club's values and the Parents' Code of Conduct. The parent(s) will receive a verbal warning, outlining the expected improvement and behaviour moving forward.

2. Second Minor Breach or First Major Breach

1. Written Warning: If a further minor breach occurs or if a more serious breach is identified, the parent(s) will receive a written warning. This will detail the nature of the breach, the expected behaviour improvements, and any impact the actions have had on the player, team, or the club's values.
2. Suspension: A suspension may be applied to either the parent(s), player, or both, depending on the situation. The suspension may involve exclusion from attending matches, training, or other club activities. The parent(s) will be informed in writing of the suspension and the specific action points that must be met before the return.

3. Exclusion from the Club:

1. If there is a third breach of the Parents' Code of Conduct, or if the behaviour continues to negatively impact the club and its coaches, managers or players then the player may be excluded from the club permanently. This decision will be communicated in writing. Membership fees will remain non-refundable.

- The club reserves the right to take prompt action to protect the well-being of the team and maintain a safe and respectful environment for all involved.
